2002 Road Project Assessment

Paul Rasmussen made a motion not to change the assessment for Robert Lushanko, 13287 Mayberry Trail. Dennis Seefeldt seconded the motion and motion adopted unanimously.

Fred Heinonen/Questioning Road Assessment

Mr. Heinonen questioned the 2002 Road Assessment as he has a corner lot facing Newgate and the driveway enters on Lakamaga Trail and he stated he did not receive an answer when he sent a letter protesting the assessment. Mr. Heinonen was informed the township office had sent him two letters explaining the amount that was assessed and how the figure is calculated between the collector roads and non-collector roads. Mr. Heinonen was also informed there is no problem with justifying the assessment as the bituminous surfacing increases the value of the property. Mr. Heinonen was informed to appeal his request to the District Court.
