ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16 AND REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON TOWNSHIP ROADS


The Town Board of New Scandia Township, Washington County, Minnesota hereby ordains:

Ordinance No. 16, of New Scandia Township shall be amended as follows:

- Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person or organization to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle to be parked on the roads, streets and by-ways of the township in areas designated as no parking zones and so posted.
- Section 2: No vehicle shall be left standing or parked for more than 60 minutes between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on any street, road or byway of the township.
- Section 3: No vehicle shall be parked on any road, street or byway of the township when such parking interferes with the removal of snow and ice from the streets and vehicles so parked shall be removed from the street by their owners within 15 minutes of demand made by a township employee for such removal and after such notice it shall be unlawful to park on said streets until the snow removal operation is completed in the area involved.
- Section 4. No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended upon the paved or improved or main traveled part of any street, road or byway in the township when it is practical to stop, park, or so leave such vehicle off such part of said street, but in every event a clear and unobstructed width of at least 20 feet of such part of the highway opposite such standing vehicle shall be left for the free passage of other vehicles and a clear view of such stopped vehicle shall be available from a distance of 200 feet in each direction upon such street.
- Section 5. Any person or organization violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall pay a fine of \$10.00. When any police officer finds a vehicle unattended upon any street or road, where such vehicle constitutes an obstruction to traffic, such officer is hereby authorized to provide for the removal of such vehicle and remove the same to the nearest convenient garage or other place of safety at the owner's expense.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
