ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 31 AND  
PERTAINING TO THE REGULATION OF DOGS WITHIN NEW SCANDIA TOWNSHIP  
AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

The Town Board of New Scandia Township, Washington County,  
Minnesota hereby ordains:

SECTION 6 of Ordinance No. 31 is hereby amended as follows:

- Section 6. No person shall keep or harbor a dog which is a public nuisance. Any dog is a public nuisance that has done any of the following:
- A. Has destroyed property or habitually trespasses in a damaging manner on property of persons other than the owner.
  - B. Has attacked or bitten a person outside the owner's or custodian's premises.
  - C. Has shown vicious habits or molested pedestrians or persons riding or driving on the public streets or highway.
  - D. Habitually barks, bays, cries, howls, or makes any other noise continuously and/incessantly for a period of 10 minutes or barks intermittently for 30 minutes or more, at any time, either day or night. A dog shall not be deemed a public nuisance if, at the time the dog is barking or making any other noise, a person is trespassing or threatening to trespass upon the private property in which the dog is situated or when the dog is teased or provoked.
