Copas, John, House

- Frame residence (ca. 1880) built on site of 1857 homestead of early settler, merchant, and farmer.
- Location: Minnesota Highway 95
- Current use: Single Family Dwelling



Erickson, Johannes, House

- Log dwelling with gambrel roof built in 1868 by Swedish immigrant Erickson.
- Location: County Road 3 & 209th St. N.
- Current use: Gammelgarden Musuem

Hay Lake School

- Brick school with bell tower built in 1895 by Scandia residents.
- Location: County Road 3 & Old Marine Trail
- Current Use: Museum, Washington County Historical Society
